Retell, in any form, a narrative that corresponds to the scripture source.

Module 2.3

What happened Mary and Joseph took Jesus to the Temple for the feast of Passover?

- What did Jesus do?
- Did he tell Mary and Joseph?
- When did they discover that Jesus was not with them?
- What did they do?
- Where did they find him?
- What was he doing? Why? *[pp. 37-38]*

Developing Knowledge & Understanding

Retell, in any form, a narrative that corresponds to the scripture source.

What happened the day that Jesus chose his first disciples?

- Who were they?
- What were they doing?
- What did Jesus tell them to do?
- What happened next?
- What did they decide to do? *[pp. 40-41]*

Developing Knowledge & Understanding

Recognise religious beliefs.

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Beliefs and Values

Talk about their own feelings, experiences and the things that matter to them.

Module 2.3

Read the account of the Ten Lepers *[pp. 43-44 or Lk 17:11-19]*

- How do you think Jesus was feeling when only one came back to thank him?
- How would you have felt?
- Do you always remember to thank those who help you?
- Why is it important to say, 'Thank You' to Jesus and to others?

Meaning & Purpose

Ask wondering questions about miracles and recognise that some questions are difficult to answer.

- How do you think Jesus managed to multiply the loaves and fish? Do you know anyone who can do that?
- What does it tell us about Jesus?
- Why do you think Jesus works miracles?
- What did Jesus do to the man who was paralysed?
- How did he do it?
- What does it tell us about Jesus?
