

3. Called to Change

<p>The sacrament we receive when we confess and receive forgiveness for our sins.</p>	<p>When someone forgives someone else, pardons or lets them off.</p>
<p>In the Sacrament of Reconciliation when you tell the priest your sins.</p>	<p>A prayer to say how sorry we are for our sins.</p>
<p>A prayer or something else to show we want to make things right with God, or others we have hurt.</p>	<p>In the Sacrament of Reconciliation when the priest, in the place of Jesus, 'absolves', forgives your sins.</p>

3. Called to Change

<p>Forty days of preparing for Easter. It starts on Ash Wednesday</p>	<p>A promise to change for the better, which we can make at the start of Lent.</p>
<p>To be sorry for the wrong things you have done and to want God's forgiveness.</p>	<p>The first day of Lent, when we receive the ash on our foreheads.</p>
<p>The day when Jesus rose from the dead.</p>	<p>To do something kind to someone.</p>
