State, name, list, describe, label, recall	Know	<p>What did God ask Jonah to do? Did he obey God? What happened?</p> <p>In your own words give a short account of what happened at the Annunciation.</p> <p>What prayer do you know that reminds you of the Trinity?</p>
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	Recall	<p>What do you know about Jonah?</p> <p>What do you know about the first Christmas?</p> <p>Look at the picture on page 36. What is happening?</p>
