Learn the following words and what they mean.

Jewish – the religion which began with Abraham and to which Jesus belonged	Synagogue – a place where Jews gather together to read the word of God
Laws – important rules	Torah – the first five books of the Old Testament
Religion – belief in the existence of a superhuman power	Rabbi – a teacher of the Jewish faith
Schema – a name given to the list of the most important beliefs of the Jews	Presented – all first-born Jewish males were brought to God at the temple in Jerusalem to show that they belonged to him
Ark – The place where the Ten Commandments were kept	Scrolls – long sheets of rolled up paper where the word of God is written
Service – a religious meeting where the word of God is read	Messiah – the person who God promised would save his people
Salvation – to be saved by God from sin and death	Glory – the praise for something that has been done well
Chosen one – The person who God promised would save his people	Commandments – instructions which God gave to us
Mission – teaching or preaching the word of God	Galilee – the area around the Sea of Galilee which Jesus live and taught
