Judge, construct case for or against, invent, predict, plan, assess, interpret, negotiation	<b>Evaluate</b>	<p>“Pier Giorgio should be canonized.” Discuss.</p> <p>“Fr. Damien should not have risked his life helping people with leprosy.” Discuss.</p>
Select, decide, give informed opinions, conclude, debate, discuss, recommend, rate, reason, contrast	<b>Justify opinions</b>	Bl. Pier Giorgio was a problem for teachers. Do you think he should be canonized a saint? Give reasons to justify our opinion.
Analyse, explain, investigate, compare, demonstrate, adapt	<b>Analyse</b>	In what ways was Bl. Miguel Pro a true follower of Jesus?
Compare, solve, show, use, illustrate, complete, classify, explain, demonstrate	<b>Apply/Use your knowledge</b>	In 1 Cor 13:4-7, St. Paul explains what Jesus meant by love. Give examples of what you are like when you live like this. (PB p. 45)
Summarise, outline, interpret compare, reword, describe, give an example	<b>Understand</b>	What do we have to do to be a faithful follower of Jesus? Give examples.
State, name, list, describe, label, recall	<b>Know</b>	What are the Beatitudes? Name one of them.
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	<b>Recall</b>	Look at the picture of Fr Damien on page 47. What do you know about him?
