Compare, solve, show, use, illustrate, complete, classify, explain, demonstrate	Apply/Use your knowledge	What happened to Saul on the road to Damascus? How did this experience help him? What can we learn from it? [SB p. 69]
Summarise, outline, interpret compare, reword, describe, give an example	Understand	What happened at Pentecost? What effect did it have on the Apostles? [SB pp. 64-65]
State, name, list, describe, label, recall	Know	Name three things Jesus asked his chosen disciple to do? [SB p. 63]
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	Recall	Who did Jesus choose to be the leader of the Church? [SB pp. 66-67]
