See guidelines for evaluating it.* [SB pp. 85 -89]</p>
Select, decide, give informed opinions, conclude, debate, discuss, recommend, rate, reason, contrast	Justify opinions	<p>"The sacraments are the most precious gifts God could give to us." Think of what the sacraments can do for us. Give informed reasons why you agree or disagree with this statement. [SB pp. 84-87]</p>
Analyse, explain, investigate, compare, demonstrate, adapt	Analyse	<p>What is the Sacrament of Reconciliation? What should we do:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• before receiving it? (3 things)</li> <li>• when receiving it? (3 things)</li> <li>• after receiving it? (2 things) [SB p. 99]</li> </ul>
Compare, solve, show, use, illustrate, complete, classify, explain, demonstrate	Apply/Use your knowledge	<p>How would you help Nicodemus to understand what Jesus said to him. Give examples from your own knowledge of the Sacrament of Baptism. [SB pp. 88-89]</p>
Summarise, outline, interpret compare, reword, describe, give an example	Understand	<p>Explain what happens in the Sacrament of Baptism. Say why you think it is important for all people. [SB pp. 84 &amp; 89]</p>
State, name, list, describe, label, recall	Know	<p>Name three sacraments. Describe one of them. [SB p. 86]</p>
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	Recall	<p>What is a sacrament? [SB p. 84]</p>
