Summarise, outline, interpret compare, reword, describe, give an example	Understand	What did Jesus want the people to understand by the miracle of loaves and fish? [SB pp.49-51] How do we fulfil our part in this New Covenant? [SB p. 54]
State, name, list, describe, label, recall	Know	What is the Covenant that Jesus has made with us? [SB p. 53]
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	Recall	How did Jesus feed the 5,000? [SB pp. 48-49]
