Analyse, explain, investigate, compare, demonstrate, adapt	Analyse	Jesus suffered physically, emotionally and psychologically. From your study, give an example of each type of suffering he experienced.  In what ways does Jesus continue to suffer in people today?
Compare, solve, show, use, illustrate, complete, classify, explain, demonstrate	Apply/Use your knowledge	In what ways are Christians likely to be helped by the suffering and death of Jesus?
Summarise, outline, interpret compare, reword, describe, give an example	Understand	What do you think caused Jesus to suffer most grievously in the Garden of Gethsemane? [SB pp. 74-75]
State, name, list, describe, label, recall	Know	When Jesus entered Jerusalem, what were the expectations of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the religious leaders?</li> <li>• the people? [SB p. 71]</li> </ul>
Repeat, label, recognise, imitate, talk about own experience	Recall	What happened when Jesus entered Jerusalem? [SB p. 71]
