GOD – CREATOR AND SUSTAINER

GOD SPEAKS to us today by God's Word in Scripture. From reading the Bible we can learn

a) something about the God who speaks and b) how we ought to respond.

To do Read the Genesis Creation account below (this misses out some of the scripture).

Day One

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ²Now the earth was a formless void, there was darkness over the deep, and God's spirit hovered over the water. ³God said, 'Let there be light', and there was light. ⁴God saw that light was good, and God divided light from darkness. ⁵God called light 'day', and darkness he called 'night'.

Day Two and Day Three

⁶God said, 'Let there be a vault in the waters to divide the waters in two'. And so it was. ... ⁸God called the vault 'heaven'. ⁹God said, 'Let the waters under heaven come together into a single mass, and let dry land appear'. And so it was ... and God saw that it was good.




¹¹God said, 'Let the earth produce vegetation seed-bearing plants, and fruit trees bearing fruit with their seed inside, on the earth'... God saw that it was good.

Dav Four and Dav Five

¹⁴God said, 'Let there be lights in the vault of heaven to divide day from night ... And so it was ... God saw that it was good.

²⁰God said, 'Let the waters teem with living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth within the vault of heaven'. And so it was ...God saw that it was good. ²²God blessed them, saying, 'Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the waters of the seas; and let the birds multiply upon the earth'.



²⁴God said, 'Let the earth produce every kind of living creature, cattle, reptiles, and every kind of wild beast'. And so it was ... God saw that it was good.

²⁶God said, 'Let us make man in our own image, in the likeness of ourselves ...

²⁷God created man in the image of himself ... male and female he created them.

²⁸God blessed them, saying to them, 'Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth ... Be masters of the fish of the sea, the birds of heaven and all living animals on the earth.' ... And so it was. ³¹God saw all he had

made, and indeed it was very good.
