- c) What does this miracle tell us about Jesus and who he is for us? [p. 44]

Show knowledge and understanding of those actions of believers which arise as a consequence of their beliefs.

- What do Catholics do in preparation for Holy Communion?
- Why do Catholics receive Holy Communion?
- What do they do when they have received Holy Communion? [p. 57]

*Make links & Connections between **beliefs and worship.***

WTL Pupil Book 6

What is the link between what **Jesus said** at the **Last Supper** and what you believe happens at the **Consecration of the Mass**?

[Last Supper p. 47; The Consecration pp. 54-55]

(If pupils are not Catholics, they should say what Catholics believe happens at the Consecration of the Mass).

Show knowledge & understanding of a range of Religious Beliefs.
